

## **GLASS Steering Committee Meeting Minutes – June 2, 2015**

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:22pm. All seven members of the Steering Committee were present.
2. The Agenda, May Meeting Minutes, and the Treasurer's Report had previously been approved electronically.
3. Pride
  - a. Happy Hour
    - i. It was agreed to split the GLOBE/CSA happy hour before the Pride Parade, totally a cost of \$127 for room reservations.
  - b. Sign / Banner
    - i. The Steering Committee agreed to employ the draft design of the GLASS logo on the official banner.
  - c. T-Shirts
    - i. Julian Miller acknowledged that he was finalizing the order for the t-shirts to be ready before the Pride parade.
  - d. 5K Race
    - i. The Steering Committee acknowledged that they would send a reminder email to any member wishing to participate in the official Pride 5K on June 12, 2015.
  - e. Pre-parade party
    - i. The Board agreed to accept LGBT CSA's invitation to the CSA pre-parade get-together.
4. Future Events
  - a. Speaker Series
    - i. Wednesday, June 10<sup>th</sup> was set for the date for the GLASS Speaker Series with Senator Sherrod Brown.

- ii. The Board agreed to attempt to send reminders through Senator Reid’s newsletter, an intern coordinator blast, and through DPCC routes.
  - b. Victory Reception
    - i. It was agreed to attend, speak at, and reminder members about the Victory Fund reception scheduled for June 17<sup>th</sup>.
  - c. Night OUT
    - i. It was also agreed to remind members about the scheduled Nats Night OUT on June 17<sup>th</sup>.
  - d. Volunteer Opportunity
    - i. Andrew Fuentes reminded members about the “So Others Might Eat” volunteer opportunity on Saturday, June 13<sup>th</sup>. The volunteer event was scheduled to last from 9am to 12pm.
- 5. Mentorship Program
  - a. It was discussed to reach out to Senator Reid’s Diversity Initiative to leverage the mentorship program opportunity with GLASS.
  - b. The idea was thrown around to post a flyer next to the corkboard at Cups & Company.
- 6. Professional Development Ideas
  - a. Post-SCOTUS
    - i. The idea was revisited to potentially host a briefing following the Supreme Court’s late-June ruling on same-sex marriage. No official timeline or agenda was set.
  - b. DADT
    - i. The Board also discussed hosting a “Don’t Ask, Don’t Tell” briefing in honor of the 5-year anniversary of the policy’s repeal. No official timeline or agenda was set.
